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Medina threat fading

Raleigh, N.C. – Debra Medina’s strong standing in Public Policy Polling’s last survey of the Texas Republican primary for Governor has faded and the race once again looks like it will come down to incumbent Rick Perry and challenger Kay Bailey Hutchison.

Perry leads with 40% to 31% for Hutchison and 20% for Medina, suggesting that a runoff is likely unless the Governor picks off most of the remaining undecideds.

It’s not that Republicans in Texas dislike Hutchison, but they’d prefer she remain in the Senate. 37% of primary voters say that’s where they’d like her to serve compared to 31% who wish she would leave elected office and 24% who would like her as Governor.

As for Medina, she has seen a significant rise in her negatives over the last two weeks. Her favorability was 40/9 on the last poll but has now declined to 36/30. 50% of primary voters think that she does or might believe that the federal government was involved in the 9/11 attacks and with those voters she trails 51-30-7.

The numbers tell a story of a party divided- 40% of primary voters disapprove of the Republican Party’s current direction to 37% who are happy with it. And 48% think the party’s too liberal to 26% who think it’s where it should be ideologically. Nevertheless the incumbent still leads.

“The better voters have gotten to know Debra Medina the less they’ve liked her,” said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. “Her presence in the race may send Rick Perry and Kay Bailey Hutchison into a runoff but that’s about it at this point.”

Bill White looks to have the Democratic nomination pretty much locked up, getting 59% to just 12% for Farouk Shami.

PPP surveyed 361 likely Democratic primary voters and 400 likely Republican primary voters from February 19th to 21st. The margin of error for the Democratic survey is +/- 5.2% and for the Republicans it’s +/-4.9%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
